Free and Reduced Lunch Forms

The forms for the National School Lunch Program can be accessed online or picked up in the faculty/secretary or counseling office at CCHS. In order to qualify for the free/reduced lunch program, you must complete a new lunch application. If your child has been direct certified for this program for the 2018-2019 school year you will receive a letter indicating their direct certified status. Those qualifying for free or reduced lunch will also have a waiver for certain school fees. Please complete and return the new form as soon as possible.

Back to School Basics for Freshman and New Students

We are excited to offer online registration this year through our parent portal. You can easily follow the steps within the online registration box and complete most of the process online. However, freshman and new-to-the district students will attend registration and orientation on Tuesday, August 7th. Registration will be from 8:30am to 12:30pm and 2:00pm to 6:00pm. Parents may register your student any time during these hours. Completing information online will speed up your process on that day.

SCHOOL FEES

School fees are \$50.00 for textbook rental, identification card, locker rental, lab and material fees, including one PE uniform for freshman and new students to the district. Some courses may require an additional fee throughout the school year, but the majority of course fees are covered with the above cost.

Physical Education students are required to wear a physical education uniform which consists of a gray tee-shirt and black shorts, both imprinted with the "CCHS Physical Education" logo. The price of the entire uniform is \$ 15.00 (\$ 10.00 for shorts and \$ 5.00 for tee-shirts) Uniforms may be purchased in the Physical Education Department. The physical education uniform will be standard for the student's entire high school years. [Freshman and new students to the district will be given one PE uniform when they begin school, and all subsequent uniforms will have to be purchased.](#)

ATTENDANCE

We would like to share with you what we feel is a mutual concern. Regular and prompt attendance is the keynote to achieving success in school. When sickness, emergency, or other valid cause necessitates absence, Parent(s) or guardian (s) MUST telephone the attendance office (457-3371, ext. 260 or 232) between 8:00 am and 3:00 pm on the day of the absence. The failure of the parent or guardian to excuse the student by 3:00 pm on the day of absence may cause the attendance to be considered unexcused.

Medical Forms

There is important information needed for the school nurse. There is a medical survey form you will complete online. If you do not complete this online you will have to complete the paper forms provided in Terricare.

Athletics

Pre-Season Athletic Registration: All athletes must complete an Athletic information packet & have a current physical on file in the Athletic Office. Packets may be picked up in the Athletic Office.

Band

If you plan on participating in the Marching Band and have not yet been attending rehearsals, please email greg.townsend@cchs165 as soon as possible. One year of band experience is required for band; none is required for the auxiliary squads.

School Lunch and Breakfast Program

Carbondale Community High School serves meals each school day. Students may buy lunch for \$2.90 and breakfast for \$1.50. Students may also receive meals free or at a reduced price. The reduced price is \$.40 for lunch and \$.30 for breakfast. To receive free or reduced price meals for your child, you must complete the lunch application unless you are direct certified.

Student Accident Insurance

The District will provide school-time blanket insurance coverage for all students enrolled in the school. This coverage includes all school-related activities and interscholastic sports, including football.

This policy should be considered **excess coverage** over any other insurance a student may have. Comprehensive policies held by parents/guardians are still primary, with the District provided coverage being secondary. Subject to limitations, the coverage will pay up to a maximum of \$25,000.00 per accident. MANDATORY SCHOOL PHYSICALS FOR FRESHMAN AND NEW TO THE DISTRICT STUDENTS

All incoming freshman and any new to the district student **MUST** present a current and complete school physical form with up to date immunization records. This is required before school begins. If you have not turned your completed forms in yet, you will be asked for these forms at the August 7th registration date. Make your appointment now! **Failure to comply with the above requirements by the date established for registration of the current school year may result in the student's exclusion from school until the required health forms are presented to the district.**
