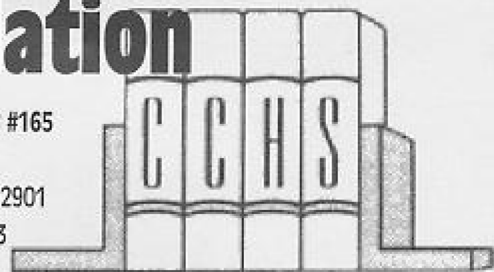

Scholarship Updates

The John Gilbert Summer Enrichment Program will be funded through private donations, Capora/Moore Grant and school district funds.

For the Class of 1940, their latest donation brings its total to \$24,225 for their scholarship pro-

gram. This fund provides two \$300 scholarships for seniors through the Foundation.

The Buser Award provides one \$500 scholarship, while the Zieba Fund provides one \$300 Scholarship. These scholarships are awarded in the Spring.

Bank of Carbondale Scholarship Program

Last Fall, The Bank of Carbondale established the Community Scholarship Program as part of The American Banker's Association "Banks of Promise" effort.

On Monday, May 6, the first of the scholarship winners were announced, for five area seniors, \$2,000 per year for four years. The bank has committed to funding over the next 30 years that will result in over a million dollars of scholarships awarded to graduating seniors in the southern Illinois area. "We're very pleased to be able to make this long-term commitment to the future of students in our communities," said Bank of Carbondale President, Robert Bleyer.

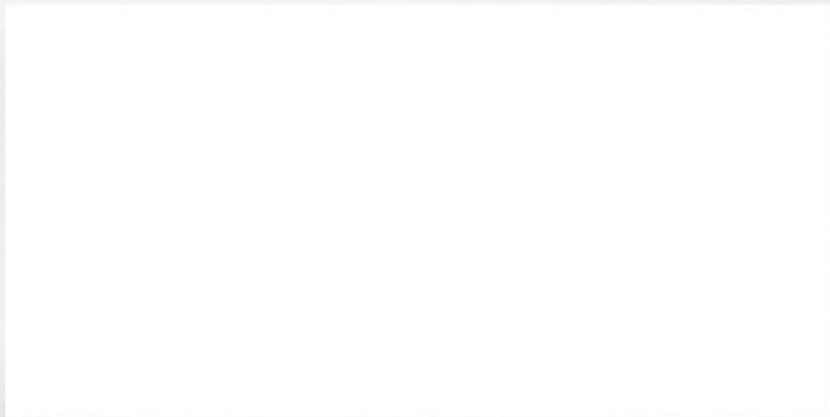
