Civics

American History (2nd Semester)

Your participation in the Credit Recovery program is subject to departmental approval.

English: You may only participate in English credit recovery if your semester average is at least 30%. If you failed the entire year, you must complete one semester of English credit recovery before beginning the other semester.

Mathematics: You may only participate in credit recovery math classes if you passed one semester of the course during the past year. If you failed the entire year (both semesters) you will be placed in the same class in the fall.

Civics: You may participate in the credit recovery for Civics if your average is 40% or higher for the semester. <u>Credit recovery for Civics and American History will be in Room J118</u>.

If you are successful at completing the tutoring and required exams, we will replace the F with a D (60%) for the failed semester of the course. This will help with your required graduation requirements and get you on the path for college level courses.

If you have any questions, see your Counselor.

The summer program begins May 30, 2017. There are only three weeks available this summer, so be sure to start early and attend regularly to make sure that you will fulfill your required hours. Your time is tracked by the minute based on the time you spend working, not just if you show up. You must sign in and sign out every day. You may attend up to four hours per day.

You do not have to sign up early for Credit Recovery but you must attend the first week to sign up and get started on your program.

Credit Recovery Guidelines:

To get credit for one semester of English you must:

- Have a semester percentage between 50 to 59%, attend at least 20 hours of Credit Recovery in English, and with a semester percentage between 30 to 49%, attend at least 30 hours of Credit Recovery in English.
- Read an assigned book and pass an objective test over it.
- Satisfactorily write one essay and two to four journal assignments about the book.

To get credit for one semester of IAG1, IAG2, IAG3, Algebra 1 or Algebra 2 you must:

- Attend at least 20 hours of the Credit Recovery in Algebra 1 or 2.
- Participate in lessons, reviews, and online programs to cover course topics
- Pass an exit exam for course material

To get credit for one semester of Geometry you must:

- Attend at least 20 hours of the Credit Recovery in Geometry.
- Complete the worksheet packet for each chapter, and correct it until it is 100%.
- Sem 1: Chapters 1-5 Sem 2: Chapters 6, 7, 8, 11, 12, and 13.1-13.3
- Score at least 60% on each chapter test. Students get two chances to pass the test.

To get credit for second semester American History or Civics you must:

- Have a semester average of 40% or higher.
- Attend at least 20 hours of the Credit Recovery in the selected class.
- Complete all worksheet packets and/or power points for each chapter and successfully complete the chapter assessments.
- Successfully pass the exam at the end of the course
