



ASSESSMENT INFORMATION

Register on your own & ensure you have a score on file when applying for college.

College-bound students are encouraged to sign up for at least one SAT or ACT (or both) as soon as possible. This is to ensure you have a score on file by the time you apply to college. The soonest you can *plan* to test is in June (with ACT), and this said with caution (as we don't know each day what will be cancelled, extended, or rescheduled). ISBE & College Board are working to come up with a plan to still provide a school-day SAT; however, this plan may be too late to receive the scores you need for college admissions and decisions.

SAT Summer Dates

August 29 – next available date

*Registration will open the week of May 25 (including additional September test date)

ACT Summer Dates

June 13 at SIUC – registration deadline of May 8

July 18 at SIUC – registration deadline of June 19

Fee Waiver Information

If you register for a test and you are Free/Reduced Lunch, PLEASE LET MRS. ANTRIM KNOW AS YOU QUALIFY FOR A FEE WAIVER TO COVER THE COST OF EACH TEST (used at registration online for payment).
