How can you help at home?

- goals & personality of the student are well matched with those of the college; this helps in finding the right fit for college.
- o Encourage your student to sign up for college visits, fairs, etc.
- o Be aware of college admissions requirements (HS courses, GPA, SAT scores).
- o Help your student stay organized (follow College Planning: 11th Grade handout provided in students' red folder) and set goals for the year.
- o Urge your student to study for the SAT in April (utilize Naviance, College Board, & Khan Academy).
- o Search together colleges that meet your child's needs (check out this website).
