Class of 2022,

Are you as excited as I am to start the new school year? I hope so! I have just a few things to help prepare you for next Tuesday:

- First day; August 14th, it is a half day. First hour starts at 8:30 am and 6th hour ends at 11:45 am. August 15th is a full day.
- Please look over your schedules one last time to make sure you have 6 classes listed. If you are missing a class, then you will need to come to the counseling office during that hour. For example; if you are missing a 3rd hour, go to your 1st and 2nd hour, then come to counseling during 3rd hour. *August 6th was the deadline to change classes, at this time we are not changing any schedules.
- I've received a few emails regarding lunches:
 - If you have Lunch A on your schedule, your lunch time is 11:30-12:00. You go to your first 3 classes and then lunch.
 - If you have Lunch B, your lunch time is 12:30-1:00. You go to your first 4 classes then lunch. I know, it's a little confusing but you'll get it.
- I've also had questions about supplies. Typically, teachers will let students know on the first day what supplies they will need. I have emailed core class teachers and here is a short list of things you will need. Please keep in mind teachers will go over supply lists and there may be additional supplies. Elective classes are not listed.

English: Loose-leaf paper, a two-pocket folder or three-ring binder, pens/pencils, and at least one pen of a different color, college ruled spiral notebook 100 pages. For Mr. May's class you will need a 1.5" 3-ring binder. Optional: 1 pad of post-it notes, 1 box of tissues and/or 1 case of pencils, and hand sanitizer

Math: Pencils, paper, and a scientific calculator. Scientific calculators typically cost between 12-15 dollars at Wal-Mart. For Mr. Arvanis's class you will need a spiral notebook.

Science: Folder with prongs, paper, pens and pencils. Optional: calculator, colored pencils, glue sticks.

Social Studies: Class specific three ring binder, class specific spiral notebook, mechanical pencils. Mr. Merriman will be giving 5 bonus points for students who bring, (to be left and used in class) a small package of colored pencils, bottle of germ-x, or package of tissue (just one of the items).

***Mrs. Ruiz's suggestions; designate one color for each subject, this will help keep you organized. Lockers are a wonderful thing, don't be afraid to use them. Also, the temperature in the building fluctuates; bring a jacket. If you need any help with supplies or organization, please let me know.
