CLARIFYING PURPOSE

WITH THE PURPOSE STATEMENT TOP OF MIND, WE WANT TO COMPLETE THE SRO RESPONSIBILITIES DESCRIPTION THROUGH THOUGHT PARTNERSHIP ON THE DRAFT **DOCUMENT AND BY IDENTIFYING WHAT THE POSITION IS** NOT. AS WE CONCLUDE THIS COLLABORATIVE EFFORT, WE **ALSO WANT TO REFLECT ON OUR EXPERIENCE THROUGH** THIS PROCESS.

SRO RESPONSIBILITIES REVIEW

STEP 1. SPLIT INTO THE SMALL GROUPS FROM THE DECEMBER MEETING, FOCUSED EITHER ON: SAFETY, EDUCATION, AND COMMUNITY RELATIONS. TAKE NOTE OF THE FOCUS AREA YOU WILL TRANSITION TO FOR REVIEW ROUND 1:

STEP 2. (10 MIN) AS A GROUP, FIRST SHARE 'ROUND THE HORN WHAT YOU LIKE ABOUT THE RESPONSIBILITIES DESCRIPTION FOR YOUR FOCUS AREA, AND THEN WHAT TWEAKS YOU MIGHT MAKE. ENSURE ONE TEAM MEMBER CAPTURES ANY RECOMMENDED TWEAKS TO THE DESCRIPTION.

STEP 3. (30 MIN) REPEAT STEP 2 WITH THE NEXT FOCUS AREAS LISTED. FOLLOWING THIS STEP, YOU WILL HAVE REVIEWED BOTH OF THE FOCUS AREAS YOU DID NOT INITIALLY DRAFT IN DECEMBER. SHARE ALL NOTES WITH SUPERINTENDENT BOOTH.
