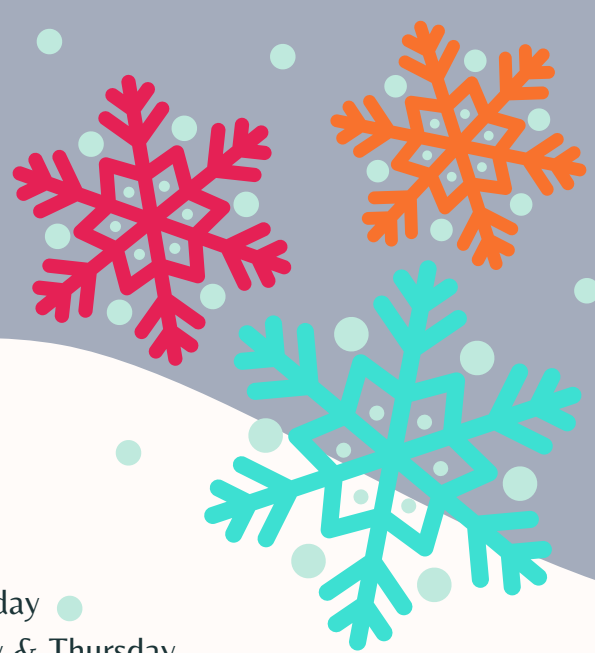

Class Learning Styles

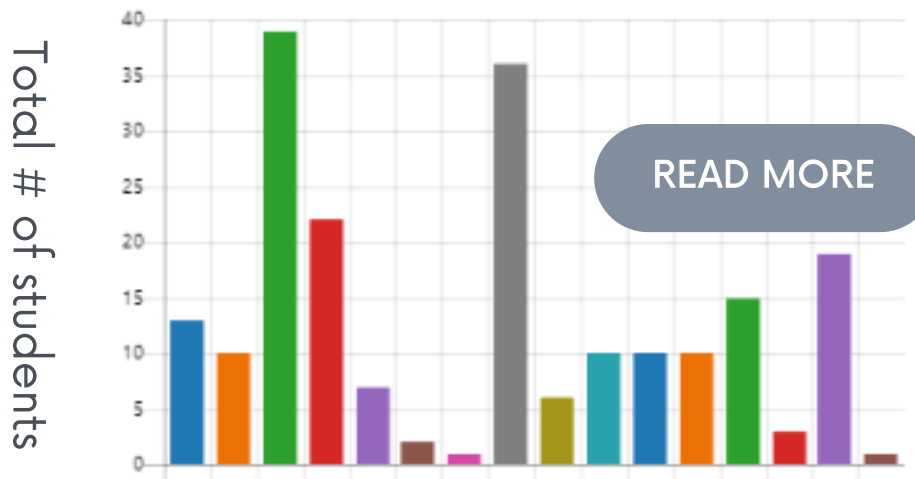


3. What career area (aka career cluster) best represents your interests?
