- Dual Credit-- Taught by a CCHS teacher
- Dual Enrollment-- Taught on the JALC campus or online
  - Students receive JALC college credit for BOTH dual credit and dual enrollment courses. CCHS students do not receive high school credit for dual enrollment courses

## SIGN-UP & APPLY

- Sign up in [SCOIR](#) to meet with a JALC Advisor on April 8
- You must apply to JALC if you have never taken a dual credit/enrollment class before. [Complete this JALC application](#)
- You may enroll in Summer and/or Fall classes at this time.

## TAKE THE ACCUPLACER TEST

- Any student taking a dual credit or dual enrollment class next year must take the ACCUPLACER to be eligible for these classes
  - **\*\*EXCEPTION: Your SAT score may be used instead\*\***
- [The test will be offered in the CCHS Library after April 8, official date TBA soon](#)
  - Bring your chromebook and a pencil
- If you are unable to test on at CCHS, you will need to schedule a time to take it at JALC in order to take the dual credit and/or dual enrollment classes in summer/fall
- Info and an admissions ticket will be provided to student prior to the test date

## ADDITIONAL INFO

- **Check your email often** - JALC will email your invoice and course information
- Dual enrollment classes have up to 8 credit hours of tuition waived per semester but will require payment of fees if the course has a fee and books if required
- Failing to pass/complete dual enrollment classes will:
  - Affect your financial aid eligibility
  - Appear on your college transcript & lower your college GPA
